


Exploration Summer Camp

Ever wanted to...

- Build and launch a rocket taller than yourself
- Paddle a canoe down a river
- Fly in a small airplane
- Turn your toothbrush into a robot
- Launch a zucchini
- Bake bread, cake, or...slime
- Learn to ride a bike with no hands
- Explode a model volcano (No, not baking soda!)
- Sketch a tree...or a spider
- Stalk (and eat) fresh blueberries

Each one week session includes a 4 to 5 mile canoe excursion on the St. Joseph river, building and launching model rockets and airplanes, and an all-day behind-the-scenes visit to the airport for a close up look at small aircraft and — weather and pilot schedule allowing—a short airplane flight. We will bike several times a week, including to the canoe excursion, our rocket launch site, and take other leisurely scenic rides to South Bend and Mishawaka sites such as museums, the organic blueberry farm, the river paths, or the swimming pool.

We have many campers who attend multiple weeks. We ensure that every week includes different adventures and new challenges.



Explore, Experiment, Experience

Paddle

Our canoe excursions will be based out of St. Patrick's County Park in South Bend. Rental for the canoe equipment, life jacket, and the along-river shuttle is included in the activity fee.

Fly

Our aeronautics experiments and flights will be based out of South Bend Regional Airport one day per week. For that day (TBD weekly) only, drop off and pick up will be at the airport, a map will be included with permission forms.

Bike

We will teach basic road and path biking skills. Each camper needs a road-worthy bike with at least 24" wheels, helmet, bike lock, backpack, and two reusable, refillable water bottles each camp day that we are not at the airport. A spare tire inner tube is strongly recommended.

Launch

We launch solid fuel model rockets every Friday from 2:00-3:30pm—weather and flight schedule allowing. Parents/family are welcome to attend launches. Pick up on launch day is at the launch site. A map will be included with permission forms. Novice rocket scientists normally start with level one rocket kit construction. Advanced rocket scientists may elect higher level kits or design their own rockets. If launches are cancelled for weather or flight conflicts, campers may bring their rockets to any other camp session launch date.

Lunch, snacks, and release forms

Each camper should bring their own lunch, sunscreen, and bug repellant. Snacks will be provided. Please note that each camper will need to have three permission forms on file when their camp session starts: a general camp release form, a canoeing release form, and a flying release form. Please note medical conditions and food allergies on the general release form.
